



### Empowering Students through Apple Technology

Over the last 8 years, Inglewood Junior School has been on an extraordinary digital journey, transforming the learning experience for its students and enhancing the teaching practices of its educators.

This case study delves into the journey that Inglewood Junior School has taken to becoming an Apple Distinguished School, highlighting the impact on student learning, teacher workload, and overall school management.

We spoke to Matthew Squires, Apple Learning Leader at Inglewood Junior School, to learn the full impact of their iPad deployment what they have planned for the future.



### The Start of the Journey

In 2016, Inglewood Junior School embarked on its journey with Apple technology, starting by implementing shared iPad devices across two separate year groups.


Working with the team at Sync, the school strategically implemented a digital action plan, mapping out a gradual progression towards a fully realised 1:1 iPad deployment by 2018, providing every student and teacher with their own device. The aim being to introduce technology and enhance independence and creativity in students and creating a dynamic learning environment. They were able to keep to this plan but employing a staggered approach to deploying the devices across a number of years.

By 2019, the school had achieved the Apple Regional Training Centre (RTC) accreditation, showcasing their expertise and knowledge in using Apple technology to enhance education. Apple Regional Training Centres are a community of educators and institutions who provide online and in person training to develop the skills and confidence of educators using Apple technology inside and outside the classroom.

Matt's role naturally expanded to also becoming the RTC Manager for the school. The role entails the management of both online and in-person events such as webinars and workshops to support educators within the community to get the most out of the Apple technology within their schools.

Matt reflects on the initial stages of the deployment and highlights the significant impact the devices have had on teaching and learning:

"The introduction of iPad devices has allowed for a more student-centric approach, with children taking charge of their learning using core Apple apps like iMovie and Keynote.

The gradual transition to a 1:1 iPad deployment has seen a boost in creativity and independence among students."



### **Enhanced Impact on Teaching and Learning**

In the pursuit of enhanced student-teacher collaboration, Inglewood Junior School implemented Showbie on their classroom devices.

With a strong focus on learning and assessment, Showbie provides a cohesive means of distributing tasks, collecting student work and delivering effective feedback. The platform not only facilitated creative learning experiences at Inglewood, but also streamlined administrative tasks for its educators.

### **Bridging the Digital Equity Gap**

The heart of Inglewood's success lies in the profound impact Apple technology has had in bridging the digital equity gap between students. When considering equity in the classroom, ed tech devices provide the perfect solution - putting the same opportunities directly in the hands of students - in the form of tablet devices such as iPad.

Matt shares data highlighting the narrowing gap in academic achievement between Pupil Premium and non-Pupil Premium students since the introduction of Apple technology. The emphasis on independence and creativity has translated into improved outcomes for all students, making a strong case for the positive influence of iPad in education.
