Device management & teaching tools.

For Northfield, the key to a successful implementation of iPad within the classroom is automation, device management and acknowledging the ability level of users.

For effective management of the school's Apple estate, Northfield advocates for **Jamf School**. This has been instrumental in the ongoing maintenance and management of devices as Jamf School connects every essential system in play, such as Salamander Soft and Office 365, to enable fast onboarding, Single-Sign On and effective safeguarding measures.

It is important to the school to focus on the importance of accepting that not everyone has the same skills and experience to fully utilise iPad capabilities for teaching and learning. To enhance teachers' confidence with new technology, Northfield School & Sports College streamlined the use of applications to several Core Apps; these include Showbie, Socrative and Microsoft Teams, which are essential tools that staff must know how to utilise effectively.

CPD for Educators

An important part of deploying iPad throughout a school is to ensure staff know how to get the most out of the devices to streamline their workflows and enhance the teaching and learning in the classroom. Northfield School and Sports College have acknowledged this and developed a bespoke training course with Sync.

Alongside this, Northfield School and Sports College also host twilight evenings, which allows their staff to gather after school and attend workshops to develop their knowledge in using technology to enhance their curriculums. This includes inviting the SEND department to deliver training to fellow colleagues to develop their understanding of how technology and the built-in accessibility features on iPad can help pupils to be more independent with their learning.

Northfield School and Sports College have also been reactive in their staff CPD, with educators developing their knowledge of how using AI can reduce their work loads when used in a safe and correct manner. Northfield use their core apps such as Showbie and Socrative, alongside iPad to monitor assessment and feedback which helps to keep pupils engaged with their learning. Showbie plays a pivotal role in enhancing teaching and learning with iPad.

Showbie is used throughout the school, particularly in practical based subjects for portfolio work such as Art, Design and Technology, and Science, to record and log any practical work being done. This is a crucial tool for the school to capture pupils work and encourages an independent learning environment.

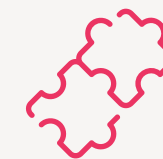
